925 AM: Westerly, RI: 1.28" in less than an hour
944 AM: Charlestown, RI: 2.02" of rain in less than an hour
1004 AM: South Kingstown RI: South County Hospital normal ambulance bay Emergency Room entrance at the hospital is flooded out and alternate location on the hospital grounds used for entry into the hospital
1010 AM: Narragansett, RI: 5 Brown Street - flooded basement of 1.5 to 2 feet with fire department water pump needed - Route 1 on ramp past the rotary - several inches of street flooding to the point of not seeing the painted road lines in the roadway, 59 Kingstown Road - flooded basement
1027 AM: Narragansett, RI: Woodruff avenue - car stuck in street flooding - flooding of about 1 foot in depth also sections of Plains Road, Ministerial Road, Curtis Corner Road and Route 108 flooded around 1 foot in depth on sections of the road
