...Confirmed Tornadic Damage from September 13th in Killingly, Foster, Glocester, Lincoln and North Attleboro..

A National Weather Service Survey Team continues to investigate storm damage from yesterday`s severe thunderstorms which moved across portions of eastern Connecticut, Rhode Island and Massachusetts yesterday afternoon.

The team has been able to confirm damage in the towns of Killingly CT, Foster RI, Glocester RI, Lincoln RI and North Attleboro MA was tornadic.

The survey team has yet to determine if the cause was from a single tornado or multiple tornado touchdowns, as well as assigning a final EF-rating, path length and path width. Those details are still unknown at this time.

The survey is still ongoing. A more detailed summary will be provided once the survey team has concluded its survey.
